## Section 300 - Fruits \& Vegetables

Entries must be displayed on white paper/ plastic plates

All varieties must be grown by the exhibitor. Entries should be washed, and outer leaves removed. Tops and roots on root vegetables trimmed to two inches. Stems on tomatoes should be left intact. Judged on uniformity, size, colour, form, free from blemishes, condition and quality. Be aware of the number requirements in each category.
